Most of us are painfully aware of the increase in the number of people experiencing homelessness over the past year. HSC and its partners are serving more clients than ever. We collectively shelter 900 individuals every night, and as many as 1,000 people are living on the streets surrounding the Campus. HSC's role in addressing this need includes the addition of a 100-bed sprung structure shelter called Respiro, an expansion of services to 24/7 in the Brian Garcia Welcome Center, and additional staffing for Street Outreach. These are in addition to the services we continue to provide, from intakes, assessments and the post office, to The Lodestar Day Resource Center Day Room, showers, safe storage and navigation to housing. Combined with all of the partner services, the Campus continues to be a special place to meet the needs of many.

These collaborative and holistic services ultimately lead to people moving into permanent housing. Your gift today allows HSC staff to serve more than 12,000 people annually, doing whatever it takes to end homelessness.
